



How players qualify for the 2007 World Championships

➤ **ITSF Point race**

Those players whose accumulated ITSF rankings points for the 2007 season place them in the top 16 in Men's and top 8 in Women's worldwide will qualify to compete in Men's Singles and Women's Singles

➤ **World Championship Series events**

The top three winners in Open Singles as well as the winner of the Women's Singles.

New this year: the winner of the Junior Singles competitions will also qualify.

➤ **Events in the "International" tournament category**

The Open Singles winners of each of the 4 International tournaments are automatically qualified

➤ **National Champions**

Players can also qualify by being designated the National Champions of their country in Men's Singles and Doubles; Women's Singles and Doubles.

New this year: the National Champions in Junior Singles and Doubles (under 18 years old on December 31st, 2006); Senior Singles and Doubles (50 years & over on December 31st, 2006) also qualify.

➤ **Wild Cards**

New this year: ITSF **Regular Member federations** benefit from special Wild Cards to have a second Men's Doubles and second Women's Doubles representing their country. ITSF Associate and Provisional Members are not entitled to these Wild Cards.
