MEMBER CATEGORIES, FEES, RIGHTS and CRITERIA for 2007-2008

Provisional Members

Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 250 €(free the first year)
Rights and Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Can send players to all ITSF official tournaments, except the World Cup ▪ Can organize Pro Tour events ▪ All their players can be in the ITSF Rankings ▪ Can vote at the General Assembly ▪ Can have representatives in the Executive Committee and/or in ITSF Commissions ▪ Can not organize upper level tournaments (Master Series, International, World Championship Series...) ▪ Can not get travel packages for their players ▪ Can not get refund from sales of ITSF licences on Official Competition Tables
Documents Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Membership application ▪ Federation's statutes (copy of the body's constitution or bylaws) ▪ List of Executive Committee's members (names and addresses)
Qualification Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be organized with bylaws acceptable to ITSF; ▪ Must be open to participation without regard to race, colour, religion, national origin, sex or sexual orientation ▪ Must fairly represent the interests of table soccer players in the country
Special Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ More than one organization within a country can be Provisional Member of ITSF

Associate Members

Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 250 € ▪ To be paid by January 1st
Rights and Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See Provisional Members' rights plus the following:</u> ▪ Can organize Master Series tournaments ▪ Can get 50% of travel package available in ITSF world events (for those players who qualify for the package) ▪ Can not organize International, World Championship Series and World Championships events ▪ Can not get refund from sales of ITSF licences on Official Competition Tables
Documents Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See documents required for the Provisional member category plus the following:</u> ▪ Registration of the federation as a non profit organization ▪ Brief history/report of the organization's activities ▪ Statement of number of active members (males – females – junior – senior)
Qualification Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See criteria required for the Provisional Member category plus the following:</u> ▪ Must hold an annual meeting and/or have another representative mechanism for electing a board of directors; ▪ Must pay dues as established by the GA;
Special Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only one Associate Member per country shall be permitted

Regular Members

Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 1 €per player - based on number of players at the end of the national federation's previous registration period ▪ Minimum: 500 € maximum: 2000 € ▪ To be paid by January 1st ▪ Member countries with a Gross Domestic Product per Capita lower than US \$13 000 can apply for a reduction (of up to 50%) of their membership fees by submitting their request to the vote of the Executive Committee
Rights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See Provisional and Associate Members' rights plus the following:</u> ▪ Can organize any official tournament in the ITSF Tour ▪ Can send players to all ITSF Official tournaments ▪ Can get refund from sales of ITSF licences on tables (20 euros for each Official Competition Table sold in your country) ▪ Can get 100% of travel package available in ITSF world events (for those players who qualify for the package)
Documents Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See documents required for the Provisional and Associate Member categories plus the following:</u> ▪ Financial statement ▪ Anti-doping Code in accordance with ITSF laws ▪ Disciplinary Code in accordance with ITSF laws
Qualification Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>See criteria required for the Provisional and Associate Member categories plus the following:</u> ▪ Must represent a minimum membership of 50 table soccer players
Special Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only one Regular Member per country shall be permitted

Please note that fulfilling all the requirements in either category doesn't guarantee a national organization will be automatically accepted as ITSF member. In all cases, the membership request has to be submitted to the vote of ITSF Executive Committee members, who reserve the right to deny a request if they deem it unacceptable (eg. conflict of interest; humanitarian issues; etc.)

Other info/documents used to determine membership category

- Organization website
- Evidence (eg. Website, photographs, media clippings, video) of national championships or other major competitive events held)
- Evidence of participation of teams in international competitions
- Evidence of regional reach within the country
- Newsletter (paper or electronic) or other communications to the membership
- Plans for development of table soccer sports and the organization
- Reference from at least one current member of ITSF
- Reference from a government agency
