



The nominations for the positions on the USTSF Board of Directors have been closed. Those receiving, and accepting the nominations are now candidates for the positions on the Board of Directors.

For the two “at-large” positions on the USTSF Board of Directors, we have the following candidates (in alphabetical order by last name):

The two candidates receiving the most votes from the USTSF State and Regional Directors during the balloting process will be elected to the Board of Directors. NOTE: the voters may vote for no more than 2 candidates on their ballot, and may leave the space blank if they feel none of the candidates are a good choice for the position.

For the Position of USTSF Treasurer, we have the following candidate:

The candidate must receive at least 50 percent of the votes from the USTSF State and Regional Directors during the balloting process to be elected to the position. NOTE: the voters may choose to leave the space blank, if they feel none of the candidate(s) are a good choice for the position.

For the position of Secretary of the USTSF, we have the following candidate:

Pat Ryan

The candidate must receive at least 50 percent of the votes from the USTSF State and Regional Directors during the balloting process to be elected to the position. NOTE: the voters may choose to leave the space blank, if they feel none of the candidate(s) are a good choice for the position.

For the position of Female Player Representative, we have the following candidate:

Shelly Langley

The candidate must receive at least 50 percent of the votes from the player balloting process to be elected to the position. NOTE: the voters may choose to leave the space blank, if they feel none of the candidate(s) are a good choice for the position.

For the position of Male Player Representative, we have the following candidate:

Tony Alvaro

The candidate must receive at least 50 percent of the votes from the player balloting process to be elected to the position. NOTE: the voters may choose to leave the space blank, if they feel none of the candidate(s) are a good choice for the position.

General overview of the voting process:

For the “at-large” positions, the USTSF Treasurer, and the Secretary of the USTSF, the voting will be done by the USTSF State and Regional Directors. Each state may cast one vote (through their State Director), and each region may cast one vote (through their Regional Director). This vote will be done by e-mail.

For the Female and Male Player Representative positions, the voting will take place at the Tornado World Championship Series event, to be held in Grapevine, TX over Labor Day weekend. Any U.S. player may vote in this election.

Results of both elections will be made public at the Tornado World Championship Series event.
